

Demolition Derby



General Information:

- 1- ALL INSCRIPTIONS TO BE DONE ONLINE or emailed to info@bromefair.com BEFORE AUGUST 19TH, 2022. Inscription cost is \$20 payable the date of the event.
- 2- All competing vehicles must arrive on the Brome Fair Grounds between 8am and 11am September 5th, 2022.
- 3- One driver, one support person and one tow vehicle will be allowed entry into the pit area with the vehicle at no cost. (This entry will not give access to the Midway) All other persons in the vehicle will be charged a \$25 entrance fee and must enter through C Gate
- 4- All vehicles are to enter the D Gate and circle behind the horse barns and park on the back side of the track.
- 5- Vehicle Inspections will begin at 8am. All vehicles that have passed inspection will be identified by spray paint.
- 6- If the vehicle does not pass inspection by 12PM, the vehicle will not be allowed to participate in the event.
- 7- The Chief inspector has the right to remove any vehicle from the competition at any time if the vehicle is deemed unsafe or poses a risk to the environment.
- 8- The Derby will be divided into different categories depending on the displacement of the engine and the size of the vehicle.
- 9- The 2022 Edition of the Brome Fair Derby will run from 1PM until 5PM Monday September 5th, 2022.
- 10- The prize money will be distributed after the event. If you have not picked up your prize money by 7pm the night of the event, the prize money is forfeit.
- 11- All vehicles must be removed from the Fairgrounds by 8pm Monday the 5th of September, 2022. If the vehicle is not removed the Fair will plan for the disposal of the vehicle and the participant will not be eligible to participate the following year.

Eligible Drivers:

- 1- Drivers must be 18 years old or older, and have a valid driver's license.

Classes:

- 1- Full Size - any 8cyl and 6cyl with a wheelbase of 113" or greater with basic modifications
- 2- Mid Size - 4cyl / 6cyl with a wheel base of 106" or greater with limited modifications
- 3- Mini Size - 4cyl / 6cyl with a wheel base of 106" or less with limited modification

Driver and Pit Crews:

- 1- All Drivers, Mechanics, and Vehicles must report to the registration desk a minimum of two hours before the start of the event (11am).
- 2- Each driver must attend the drivers meeting, held approximately 30 minutes before the scheduled start time of the competition.
- 3- A car may only be entered once per event.
- 4- Aggressive driving is limited to the track during the race. It will not be tolerated in the pit area.
- 5- All Drivers and crew are required to sign a release form prior to the race or they will not be admitted to the pit area.
- 6- There is ZERO TOLERANCE for the use of any alcohol or drugs prior to or during the race.
- 7- Brome Fair Demolition Derby reserves the right to disqualify or refuse any entry, or otherwise disqualify or eject any participant, crew member or team whose actions impede the progress, enjoyment or efficiency of the event.

Equipment & Driving Rules:

- 1- All drivers must be equipped with helmets, eye protection, and a seatbelt.
- 2- All drivers must be wearing acceptable attire to participate (no shorts, short sleeves, or tank tops)
- 3- Vehicles must have adequate brakes, and the driver must have control of his vehicle at all times.
- 4- No deliberate or aggressive driver door hits will be tolerated.
- 5- If a car catches fire while participating, the driver will be immediately disqualified.
- 6- If any door or panel comes open the event will be stopped and the participant will be removed from the event.
- 7- A driver that is not making competitive contact with other active participants will be disqualified. NO SANDBAGGING.
- 8- It is the driver's responsibility to be aware of and obey the track officials at all times. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
- 9- A heat winner or runner-up that qualifies for a feature event must drive the same vehicle in the feature race (if applicable).
- 10- No driver substitutions are allowed.

Vehicle Preparation Rules:

- 1- Numbering:
 - a. The front driver door must be painted white for numbering and identification (passenger door may also be painted white). The number will be assigned during inscription and must be painted on the white door (Minimum 24" high)
- 2- Vehicle Interior & Exterior:
 - a. All glass, decorative moldings, door handles, lights, accessories and trailer hitches must be removed, and the vehicle must be swept clean of any debris. (Windshield Optional)
 - b. The driver seat must be in good condition and reinforced in the back with a metal rod or pipe from floor to ceiling either welded or bolted in place.
 - c. It is obligatory to make two large holes in the hood to facilitate fire extinguishment.
 - d. Radiators must remain in the stock position and may **ONLY** contain water. (No Coolant)
 - e. All seats, airbags and flammable material must be removed, with the exception of the front seat(s) and dash.
 - f. The vehicle cannot be reinforced with metal, with the exception of the drivers side door. The door **CANNOT** be welded shut.
 - g. Sunroofs **MUST** be covered.
 - h. Only one 12V automobile battery is permitted and must be secured to the floor of the front passenger area, or within the passenger seat.
 - i. Doors, trunk and hood **MUST** be chained closed with 3/8" or 5/16" chain.
 - j. Sponsorship may be shown on the vehicle with the exception of the driver and passenger doors.
- 3- The Gas tank must contain a maximum of 12 liters of gas and be secured where the back seat was. The gas tank cannot remain in its original location.
- 4- All tire models are acceptable with the exception of studded tires. Tires must contain air and cannot be filled with foam, cement, or other similar substances.
- 5- Four Wheel Drive vehicles are **not** permitted.
